### **About Rod Gilmore**

Rod Gilmore is a college football game and studio analyst for ESPN. He primarily works on ESPN and ESPN2's Friday night game telecasts. He previously served as ESPN studio analyst.

Prior to joining ESPN, Gilmore worked as an analyst with Prime Sports Network, covering Pac-10 football, along with SportsChannel Bay Area, and the Pacific Sports Network. He was nominated for an Emmy Award in 1994 for live sports coverage of Pac-10 football.

A 1982 Stanford graduate with a degree in English, Gilmore was a three-year starter at defensive back and played under legendary Bay Area coaches Bill Walsh and George Seifert. He was on the field during the infamous "The Play" game in 1982 during which Cal defeated Stanford after the Stanford Band had taken to the field.

Gilmore is a former member of the Board of Directors of the Stanford Alumni Association, a current board member of Alumni Association affiliate organization Stanford Associates and has served as chairman of the Stanford Athletic Board.

An Oakland native, Gilmore is a member of the Oakland Babe Ruth Baseball Hall of Fame.

Gilmore is the husband of Alameda City Council Member and Mayoral Candidate Marie Gilmore.

### **About Darrin Nelson**

Darrin Nelson, a four-time All-Pac-10 selection and a First-Team All-American in 1981 for the Stanford Cardinal, was one of the most prolific all-purpose running backs in college football during his career.

Nelson still holds several Cardinal records, including Career Rushing Yards. Nelson became the first player in NCAA history to rush for over 1,000 yards and catch 50 passes in a season – a feat he accomplished three times in his four years at Stanford.

Nelson was selected by the Minnesota Vikings as the 7th overall pick in the first round of the 1982 draft. Nelson had a successful 11-year career in the National Football League.

Nelson is currently a Senior Associate Athletic Director at Stanford University.
